Lieutenant Colonel Janus T. Fraley was commissioned in 1998 as a Field Artillery Lieutenant following graduation from Florida Agricultural & Mechanical University in Tallahassee. His first assignment was to 1st Brigade, 1st Infantry Division, Fort Riley, Kansas where he served as a Platoon Leader and Battery Executive Officer for 1st Battalion, 5th Field Artillery and Task Force Targeting Officer for 1st Battalion, 34th Armor. After attending the Field Artillery Captains Career Course, Lieutenant Colonel Fraley was assigned to the 1st Battalion, 38th Field Artillery, 2nd Infantry Division Artillery, Camp Stanley,

South Korea where he served as the Battalion Adjutant. He was then assigned to the 3rd Infantry Division, Fort Stewart, Georgia in 2003 where he served in various leadership and staff positions. In 2005, he deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF) III as the Task Force Fire Support Officer for 3rd Battalion, 69th Armor and later assumed command of Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 1st Battalion, 41st Field Artillery prior to redeployment.

Following command, Lieutenant Colonel Fraley served as the Rear Detachment Commander for the "Glory's Guns" battalion during OIF V. Once again assigned to 1st Brigade, 1st Infantry Division in January 2009, he served as the Team Chief for the 40th Brigade, 10th Iraqi Army Infantry Division Military Transition Team (MiTT) and deployed to An Nasiriya, Iraq in support of OIF 09--11.

Upon graduation from the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, Lieutenant Colonel Fraley was assigned to the 434th Field Artillery Brigade (BCT) at Fort Sill, Oklahoma serving as the Executive Officer of 1st Battalion, 19th Field Artillery and as the Brigade S3. He most recently served as a Fires Observer, Coach, and Trainer for Operations Group Delta, Mission Command Training Program, Fort Leavenworth, Kansas where he mentored fire support personnel for Divisions, Corps, and Army Service Component Commands.

Lieutenant Colonel Fraley is a graduate of the Field Artillery Officer Basic Course, Captains Career Course, and Command and General Staff College. He has a Master of Science in Administration from Central Michigan University. His military awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, Army Achievement Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Korea Defense Service Medal, and is authorized the wear of the Parachutist Badge and Combat Action Badge.
