This Week's Program

Coach Robert Weiner

Plant High School



Entering his 14th year as Head Football Coach at H.B. Plant High School, Coach Robert Weiner has created history, taking Plant Panthers Football to a new level. Plant High School is the home of the 2006 and 2008 Florida Class 4A State Champions, the 2009 Class 5A State Champions, and the 2011 Class 8A State Champions. A Tampa Tribune story states it clearly; "Want to hear about this county's football glory days? You're living in them."

Starting with a varsity roster of only 21 players in 2004, Coach Weiner revitalized the Panthers' football program in two short years, winning the 2005 District 10 Title for the first time in 25 years, and advancing to the State Playoffs. In the magical 2006 season, with a varsity roster bulging at 80+ players, he skillfully led the Plant Panthers to a perfect 15-0 record, culminating in the first Florida Class 4A State Championship Title in Plant football history. In 2007, the Plant Panthers once again captured the District 10 championship and advanced to the regional semi-final. In an exciting and tumultuous season, the 2008 team went on to battle for and win the Panther's second Florida 4A State Championship. Following the 2008 season, Plant's football program was reclassified to 5A, and the 2009 team rallied to win the Florida Class 5A State Championship Title. In 2011, Plant again rose to the challenge of a new classification and claimed the Florida Class 8A State Championship Title!

Prior to his arrival at Plant High, Coach Weiner coached football at his alma mater Jesuit High School for 15 years. While at Jesuit, Coach Weiner was first mentored by his hero, the legendary Coach Bill Minahan (who began his career at Plant High in the 50's) and then by Coach Dominick Ciao, who stepped into the Jesuit coaching job with Coach Weiner as his assistant. In what would become the first of many accolades, Coach Weiner was bestowed the National Football Foundation's Assistant Coach of the Year Award in 2001. From Jesuit he moved on to Crystal River High School as head baseball coach, where he led the Pirates to the regional playoffs.

In 2004, Coach Weiner arrived at H. B. Plant, returning to south Tampa, just four blocks from his childhood home.

Coach Weiner has built a football program centered on discipline, stressing strong moral character and academic priority. In a commitment of time and effort beyond belief, he has expanded the program to accommodate a huge roster, providing as many young men as possible the incredible experience of being a member of the Plant Panther team. There is no off-season for Coach Weiner, who has earned invitations for the Panthers to 7-on-7 tournaments throughout the summer, most prestigiously, two trips to the Nike Headquarters in Oregon, an honor given to only eight teams in the nation. Coach Weiner's special skill as a quarterback coach is evidenced by the fact that four of his protégées have signed with Division I colleges in just ten years.

In recognition of his accomplishments, the Tampa Chapter of the National Football Foundation named him the Billy Turner Coach of the Year in 2005 and 2006. He is a back-to-back winner of the prestigious Golden Helmet Coach of the Year Award, a national honor bestowed by the Coca-Cola Company for outstanding academic and athletic performance. The Florida Dairy Farmers selected Coach Weiner as the State Class 4A Coach of the Year and the All Classifications Coach of the Year in both 2006 and 2008. Nike designated Coach Weiner as Coach of the Year for the State of Florida for three years as well. Trophies declaring him the Catch 47/Bright House Coach of the Year for two years and a recipient of The Tampa Tribune Parade of Athletes also adorn his office. In 2013, Coach Weiner was awarded the Service Through Sports Award by the Tampa Sports Academy.

Wins and losses, championships, and trophies are a shallow judgment of Coach Robert Weiner. Countless players, students, and colleagues will profess undying loyalty to a man who has committed himself to his career with immeasurable passion. They will all tell you that once you have encountered Coach Weiner, you have a teacher, a coach, a mentor, and most of all, a friend for life. Coach Weiner has instituted many traditions at Plant, all centered on the bond that forms when you truly become a team. In a tribute to Plant's football history, Coach Weiner has established the Plant Football Hall of Fame, and it is the faces of those men that the players first see as they enter the field house each day. Plant players, past and present, proudly carry a carabineer signifying that they are "always a link" in the Plant Football chain. Each season of Plant Panthers Football begins with a statement that defines the team before they set foot on the field for the first game. As we move into the 2016 season, Coach Weiner and the Plant Panthers have committed to the hard work ahead, acknowledging the varying backgrounds, gifts and abilities of every team member. One might say that Coach Weiner and his Plant Panthers are on a mission; in fact they are on THE MISSION to enthusiastically work and relentless pursue the goal of becoming the best each one of us can be as a person, a student, a player, and teammate for the sake of our Plant Football Family. ONE HEARTBEAT!

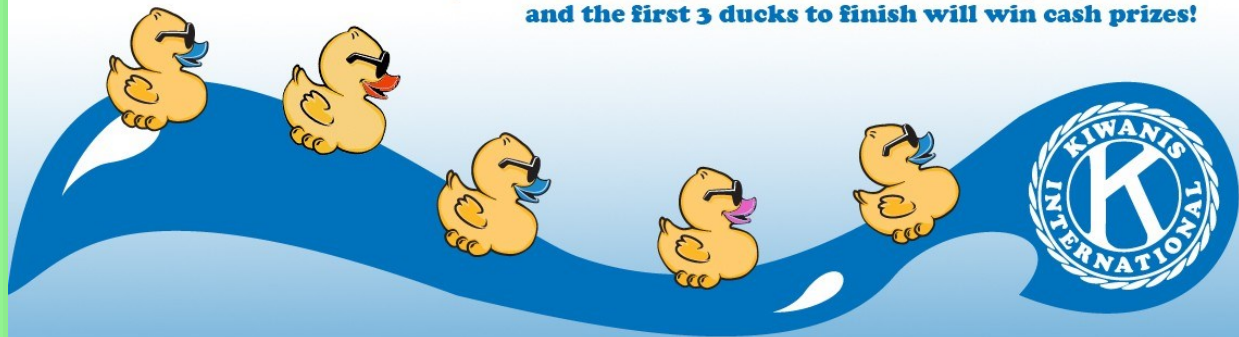
